

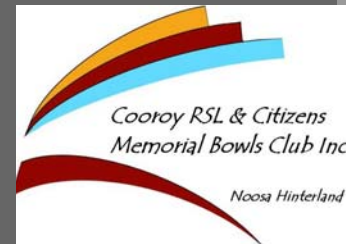

Well the Christmas break was not spent idly! A visit to Melbourne and to hang with the gang from Bowls Australia enabled between champers our keen desire to have input into future guidelines for Juniors throughout Australia, and to start the "bowl" rolling on the urgency to procure abundant juniors for the future of the sport. With the World Championships about to commence next week in NZ, and Australia looking to secure at least 2 World titles, the sport of bowls is heading into a totally new era with the Ladies World Singles title being represented by the under 20 something Kelsey Cottrell. Plans for national programs to not only secure a larger base of players to select from, but also to identify future champions and offer support in the way of elite coaching and scholarships right here in the Noosa Shire, are just a couple of exciting initiatives to work on this year!

The first meeting of the lawn bowls interest group for 2008 was held Saturday January 5th. Many issues were discussed with the focal point of the new committee to build upon the successes of the previous committee.

The 2008 bowling calendar is currently being prepared and will be issued in the next week. The first major is the May Carnival which will be held on the 3rd & 4th of May; while the Cooroy and District Traders Day is scheduled for 5th & 6th July.

Friday January 25th we have an in visit from 'Hibiscus Resort' commencing at 5pm so please get your name in early for that one. The 'Carlton Black' mixed fours on Sunday January 27th commences at 9:15am and is open to all players. With \$500 worth of prizes and just \$7 entry this is a great comp to start the year!

Remember the first Sunday of each month we have the 3 set singles commencing at 09:00am. And on the 2nd/3rd & 4th Sundays of each month we will be holding selected sponsored mixed bowls so come join the fun.

Schools Program – Will recommence in February with the qualifying rounds for the Schools Cup Challenge to see which Mixed Threes will represent our region. Once training and competition completed, and submitted to Bowls QLD in April, the scheduled schools will be operating as normal.

Juniors—A great year lined up with Noosa Heads hunting up their squad for a wee challenge with us and hopefully Tewantin Noosa and Pomona We shall also be hosting a District Junior Day as well as the ANZ Open.

Super challenge - We have awesome players all geared up to play there hearts out and bring in the \$! First home game is Jan 12—come on over and watch some great players.

The committee has decided as of Feb 1 to set the green fees for all games except major events at \$7.00 per adult and \$3.50 for juniors; this represents a small increase in some events and no increase in others. The Jackpot surcharge will remain at \$1.00 per player. Nomination fees for Club Championship events have been increased to \$3.00 per adult and \$1.50 for juniors, this is the first increase in this fee for over 15 years, and subsidises the purchase of the championship trophies.

In an effort to curb some expenditure afternoon tea in other than sponsored events will be tea/coffee and biscuits or cake.

The next general meeting of the lawn bowls interest group will be held on Saturday March 1st commencing at 09:00am in the Opal Street rooms. Also I remind you that the AGM of the Club will be held on Sunday March 9th commencing at 09:00am i
